### Pay-As-You-Play:

Curlers who choose this method will be placed on a spare list and will not be eligible to be on a team, gain seniority or compete for a trophy.

### Volunteer Bond:

More hands make for lighter work - to encourage EVERYONE in the club to participate, **the Club is requesting a \$100 volunteer bond per person, be presented with registration.**

The bond will be returned once 4 hours of a volunteer task(s) has been performed by the member.

\* Tasks are varied and include; board member, draw convener, bonspiel convener, kitchen or bar duty for bonspiel or rental, assisting ice maker (start and end of year), maintenance of club, assisting curling school or little rockers, fundraising assistance.

### Curling School:

The Club will be holding a 6-week Learn To Curl program on Monday nights from 7 - 9 pm starting October 27<sup>th</sup> through to December 1<sup>ed</sup>, 2025. Cost is only \$60. ***Spread the word!***

### Little Rockers & Junior Curlers:

We are making some exciting changes to our youth curling program this year. Beginning Sunday, November 2, 2025, the program will run from 1:00 – 2:30 pm with the cost remaining at \$75. New age categories are: Little Rocks (6–8, 30 minutes on & 30 mins off the ice), Junior Rocks (9–13), and High School Rocks (14–21), based on their age as of December 31, 2025. These updates provide curlers with more ice time and align our program with other youth curling in the area.
